- 7> Pedro Martinez Pedro has won the Cy Young Award three times. He retired in 2009.
- 8> Luis Gonalez Luis wore the number twenty. He was born in Tampa, Florida in 1967.
- 9> Miami The Miami Marlins are in the Eastern Division. This team calls Marlin Park home.
- 10> Los Angeles Dodgers The Los Angeles Dodgers were sold to the Guggenheim Baseball Management LLC. Magic is a member of this group. The deal was announced in March of 2012.
- 11> Ernie Harwell Ernie called the play-by-play for the Tigers for 42 years. His final broadcast was in 2002.
- 12> Los Angeles Angels Disney sold the team in 2003.
- 13> Great American Ball Park The cost of this park was \$290 million. It is owned by Hamilton County.
- 14> Kansas City Royals Hillman was then hired by the Los Angeles Dodgers to be their bench coach.
- 15> Chris Antonetti Chris is also the Executive Vice President.
