Answers:

- 1> Quebec - Nunavut is a larger region, but it is a territory.
- 2> Prince Edward Island - PEI has an area of 9,984,670 sq km.
- 3> Manitoulin Island - Treasure Island is an actual Island located in Canada.
- 4> Great Bear Lake - Great Bear Lake is in the North West Territories.
- 5> Calgary - The Bow River is the headwater of the Nelson River.
- 6> Mount Logan - Mount Logan is in the Yukon.
- 7> Nova Scotia - The Island is famous for its 'buried treasure' pit.
- 8> Grise Ford - Grise Ford is located on Ellesmere Island.
- 9> Cape Spear - This is actually the eastern most point of the continent.
- 10> Lake Louise - Lake Louise is 1540 meters above sea level.
- 11> Vancouver - The average temp in this city is 10 C.
- 12> Della Falls - These falls have a 440 m drop.
- 13> Ocean Falls - This city in British Columbia gets an average of 4,145 mm every year.
- 14> Arviat - Measuring north, south, east and West, Arviat in Nunavut is the centermost point.
- 15> Great Slave Lake - Great Slave Lake in the North West Territories is 615 meters deep.
- 16> Beaver Creek - This town is the Yukon Territory.
- 17> Saskatchewan - The Nelson River is 2,575 km long.
- 18> The Mackenzie River - The Mackenzie River is 4,241 km long.
- 19> Yellowknife - The average yearly temperature is -5 C.
