- 6> William Bonin William Bonin was executed in 1996, sixteen years after his arrest.
- 7> Eric Edgar Cooke Cook was nicknamed The Night Caller.
- 8> Peter Woodcock Woodcock was a child rapist and serial killer, in Canada.
- 9> Westley Allan Dodd Dodd was hung in 1993 in the USA. It was the first hanging in 28 years.
- 10> Paul Brenardo Paul is currently in a segregation cell in Kingston, Ontario.
- 11> Stephen Trantel He was also featured on American Greed.
- 12> Candice Rose Martinez A total of \$48,620 was stolen during the four robberies during October and November 2009.
- 13> Willie Sutton Sutton stole more than 2 million dollars during his forty-year criminal career.
- 14> Stella Dickson She started robbing banks with her husband when she was sixteen.
- 15> Ned Kelly Ned was hung in 1880 at Old Melbourne Gaol.
- 16> Darcy Dugan Darcy escaped from a train by cutting hole through the roof. The train is now in the Sydney Tramway Museum.
