- 1> Kiwifruits - Vitamin C is thought to lower cancer risk.

- 3> Whisky - Whiskey is made from fermented grain mash.
- 4> Tortilla - Tortillas are used to make burritos, amongst other things.
- 5> Bread - Pumpernickel originated in the Westphalia region of Germany sometime in the 1400s.
- 6> Harvey Wallbanger - A screwdriver is made with orange juice and vodka.
- 7> Fish - A coulbiac is most often filled with salmon or sturgeon, rice, mushrooms, eggs, onions and spices.
- 8> Portugal - Nando's operates about 1,000 outlets in 30 countries.
- 9> Japan - Japanese curry and ramen are also considered national dishes of Japan.
- 10> Belgium - Limburger is known for its strong smell.
- 11> Anchovies - Scotch Woodcock was a popular dish in the Victorian era.
- 12> Wasabi - Wasabi is also called Japanese horseradish.
- 13> 9 - Nine imperial gallons is equal to 10.8 US gallons.
- 14> Turnip - The turnip is the heart shield in the arms of Keutschach am See.
- 15> Iceberg - Lettuce was first cultivated by the ancient Egyptians.
- 16> Red - Water makes up approximately 93 percent of asparagus's composition.
- 17> Grape - Raisins are known to stimulate the libido.
- 18> Rum - A citrus juice (such as lime juice) and sugar complete the daiquiri.
