- 9> Terry Jones - Terry is only 5 feet 8 inches.
- 10> Ella Enchanted - Eric Idle also does the voice of Merlin in the film Shrek the Third.
- 11> 1983 - The Meaning of Life is classed as a musical, comedy sketch film.
- 12> Eric Idle - Eric wrote almost all of the songs for the show.
