- 1> 1975 - 58,220 U.S. service members died during the war.

- 5> 1995 - The bombing claimed 168 lives and injured approximately 680 people.
- 6> 1998 - The affair led to Lewinsky becoming a pop culture celebrity.
- 7> 1992 - Following the Cold War, reorganizing of Russia's economy left millions throughout the former Soviet Union unemployed.
- 8> 1981 - Reagan left the oval office in 1989.
- 9> 2003 - Among the recovered items from the disaster is a videotape recording made by the crew during the start of re-entry.
- 10> 2005 - Hurricane Katrina is one of the five deadliest hurricanes in the history of the US.
- 11> 1980 - Sixty-five countries did not participate in the 1980 Summer Olympics.
- 12> 1993 - According to the FBI, cult leader David Koresh's right-hand man Steve Schneider shot and killed Koresh and then committed suicide.
- 13> 1968 - Martin Luther King, Jr. was a leader in the African-American Civil Rights Movement.
- 14> 1950 - The U.S. provided approximately 88 percent of the 341,000 international soldiers that fought in the conflict.
