8> Whitney Houston - The film was Whitney Houston's acting debut.

9> It's Complicated - Written and directed by Nancy Meyers, the film stars Meryl Streep, Steve Martin, Alec Baldwin and John Krasinski.

10> A Matter of Life and Death - A Matter of Life and Death was released shortly after World War II ended.

- 11> Waterloo Bridge - Released in 1940, Waterloo Bridge stars Robert Taylor and Vivien Leigh.
- 12> Basketball - The film stars Omar Epps and Sanaa Lathan.
- 13> India - The film was directed by Gurinder Chadha.
- 14> EM Forster - A Room With a View won three Academy Awards including Best Adapted Screenplay.
