10> 1977 - The film was written and directed by Steven Spielberg.

11> Sleeper - Written by Woody Allen and Marshall Brickman, Sleeper was released in 1977.

12> The Day the Earth Stood Still - The Day the Earth Stood Still is based on the short story "Farewell to the Master" by Harry Bates.

13> Kristanna Loken - Terminator 3 was Schwarzenegger's final starring role before becoming Governor of California.
