- 7> Ski Jump - Ski jumping has been a part of the Winter Olympic Games since their inception in 1924.
- 8> Three - Red Rum won the Grand National in 1973, 1974 and 1977.
- 9> 1960 - The UEFA European Championship has been held every four years since 1960.
- 10> 1935 - The Bucknell Bisons beat Miami with a score of 26 to 0.
- 11> Walcott - A monument has been constructed in Barbados to the memory of three great West Indies cricketers.
- 12> Ali - Ali won his first world heavyweight championship in 1964 at the age of 22.
- 13> Saudi Arabia - Mohamed played in four FIFA World Cups for the Saudi Arabia national team.
- 14> Texas - The San Antonio Spurs joined the NBA in 1976.
