- 1> A Cross - Buffy the Vampire Slayer aired from March 10, 1997 until May 20, 2003.
- 2> Malcolm McDowell - Fantasy Island originally aired from 1977 to 1984. To the delight of many, its revival in 1998 only lasted one season.
- 3> The Good Wife - Played by Julianna Margulies, the series focuses on Alicia Florrick.
- 4> Ken Jennings - Jennings total winnings on Jeopardy! are \$3,196,300.
- 5> Saved by the Bell - Saved by the Bell was a remake of the Disney Channel series Good Morning, Miss Bliss.
- 6> Mad About You - The show lasted for seven seasons, running from 1992 to 1999.
- 7> 16 - As of 2014, Survivor has run for a total of 28 seasons.
- 8> Family Guy - Family Guy has won three Primetime Emmy Awards and three Annie Awards.
- 9> Jesus Christ - Promised Land was launched as a spin-off series in 1996.
- 10> Land of the Lost - Land of the Lost ran for three seasons - 43 episodes.
- 11> Lost - Filmed in Oahu, Hawaii, the series was one of the most expensive serials ever filmed for television.
- 12> William Shatner - Boston Legal was a spinoff of 'The Practice' where Denny Crane (William Shatner) was featured in five episodes.
- 13> NYPD Blue - Stringfield left ER early in its third season.
- 14> Tripper - Three's Company had many cast changes over its eight season run with Jack Tripper, Janet Wood and Larry Dallas being the only characters that were with the show from start to finish.
- 15> Cunningham - The first season's opening theme music was 'Rock Around the Clock' by Bill Haley and His Comets.
- 16> Californication - Californication has won two Emmy Awards and one Golden Globe Award.
