- 9> A wharf The rock has become a national monument.

- 12> Philadelphia This parade was originally sponsored by Gimbel's Department store.
- 13> Felix the Cat The balloon was used in the 1927 parade.

- 15> New York The parade starts at central park.
- 16> The Speedwell The Speedwell was deemed unseaworthy.
- 17> Buckles Buckles were not common until the 1700's.
- 18> 5 Deer meat is also called venison.
- 19> Maple syrup The pilgrims did not have ovens and therefore they would not have been able to bake a pie.
- 20> Cole's Hill The pilgrims' frequently buried their dead at night to prevent the natives from seeing.
