- 4> Zachary Taylor - In the 1980s, Taylor body was exhumed for further studies into his death.
- 5> Millard Fillmore - Fillmore was a member of the Whig Party.
- 6> Franklin Pierce - Franklin and Jane had three children.
- 7> James Buchanan - Buchanan is buried in Lancaster, Pennsylvania.
- 8> Abraham Lincoln - Lincoln was the 16th President of the United States.
- 9> Andrew Jackson - Andrew Jackson was attacked on the 6th of May 1833.
- 10> Andrew Jackson - The attack came on the 30th of January 1835. Lawrence was found not guilty by reason of insanity.
- 11> Andrew Johnson - The Senate acquitted Andrew Johnson by a single vote.
- 12> Ulysses S. Grant - Grant was the 18th President of the United States.
- 13> Rutherford B. Hayes - Hayes was wounded five times during the American Civil War.
- 14> James A. Garfield - James A Garfield took office in 1881.
- 15> Chester A. Arthur - Chester A. Arthur took office on September 19th, 1881.
- 16> Grover Cleveland - Grover Cleveland married Francis Folsom in the Blue room.
- 17> Benjamin Harrison - Benjamin Harrison died on the 13th of March 1901.
- 18> William McKinley - William McKinley was the 25th President of the United States.
- 19> Theodore Roosevelt - Theodore served as the 26th president of the United States.
- 20> William Howard Taft - Taft was the tenth Chief Justice and the 27th President.
- 21> Thomas Woodrow Wilson - Thomas Woodrow Wilson took office on the 4th of March 1913.
- 22> Warren Harding - The Ohio Gang was a group of people surrounding the President during his scandal-filled presidency.
