- 6> Susie Wake Up Little Susie was released on September 2, 1957.
- 7> The Weavers Originally recorded by Lead Belly in 1938, Gordon Jenkins and the Weaver's version was released in 1950.
- 8> 33 Released in 1956, Sam's first single was 'Lovable'.
- 9> Kay Starr Billie Holiday said Starr was 'the only white woman who could sing the blues.'
- 10> The Platters The Platters had 4 number one Billboard hits.
- 11> Roy Orbison Roy Orbison died at the age of 52 on December 6, 1988.
- 12> Heart Cold, Cold Heart was written by Hank Williams
- 13> A Big Hunk o' Love A Big Hunk o' Love was released on June 23, 1959.
