1> Nacio Herb Reed - The song was featured in many other movies, such as 'Legal Eagles' and 'A Clockwork Orange'.

2> An architect - The movie was made after a TV series and a stage play.

3> Thailand - The director of the movie, David Lean, almost died on the set of the film. He was saved from drowning in the river by Geoffrey Horne.

4> Alfred Hitchcock - The film was spoofed and referenced numerous times, notably in The Simpsons, The Flintstones and CSI.

5> Burt Lancaster - Burt Lancaster scored 19 on the American Film Institute's list of greatest male actors of all time.

6> The Wisdom of Eve - The novel was supposedly based on an actress named Elizabeth Bergner, who experienced a rather similar occurrence.

7> Ben-Hur - Only Titanic and Lord of the Rings have repeated the winning streak.

8> San Francisco - Alfred Hitchcock made great films, but he was known to be a difficult to work with.

9> Sabrina - Humphrey Bogart, on the other hand, was very unhappy during the filming of the movie.

10> The Searchers - American Film Institute named the movie the Greatest American Western of all time in 2008.

11> Yo-yo - The movie was released less than a month before Dean's fatal car accident.

12> Touch of Evil - Welles himself stars in the movie as the corrupt police officer Hank Quinlan.

13> A Faithful Hussar - The actress singing the song was Kubrick's wife, Christiana Kubrick.

15> Cocker spaniel - Lady was voiced by Barbara Luddy, but Bill Thompson voiced four characters - Bulldog, Dachsie, Jock, Joe, and the policeman.
