1> Percy Faith - Written for the 1959 film 'A Summer Place', Percy Faith recorded the most popular version of the tune which stayed at number one on the Billboard Chart for nine weeks.

2> Jim Reeves - Becoming a hit in early 1960, the song was released in November of 1959.

3> Bobby Vee - Originally recorded by The Clovers in 1955, Devil or Angel was a number one hit for Bobby Vee.

4> Everly Brothers - Released in 1960, Cathy's Clown was the Everly Brother's first single.

5> Steve Lawrence - Written by Gerry Goffin and Carole King, Go Away Little Girl was a number one hit for Steve in 1962. Donny Osmond also had a hit with the song in 1971.
6> Mark Dinning - Teen Angel reached number one on the U.S. Billboard Hot 100 in February of 1960.

7> Roy Orbison - Released in August of 1964, Oh, Pretty Women was written by Roy Orbison and Bill Dees.

8> Chubby Checker - Released in 1960, 'The Twist' gave birth to the 1960s Twist dance craze.

9> Elvis Presley - Released in October of 1961, the song was featured in the movie 'Blue Hawaii'.

10> Bob Dylan - Bob released the song on his album 'The Freewheelin' Bob Dylan' in 1963.

11> The Beatles - Written primarily by John Lennon, 'A Hard Day's Night' was released on the movie soundtrack of the same name in 1964.

12> The Mamas and the Papas - Released in December of 1965 on the album 'If You Can Believe Your Eyes and Ears'.

13> The Troggs - 'Wild Thing' was originally recorded by The Wild Ones in 1965, but is best known for its 1966 cover by The Troggs.

14> The Turtles - Knocking The Beatles' song Penny Lane from the number one slot on the Billboard Hot 100, Happy Together was released in February of 1967.

15> The Drifters - Released in 1960 from the album 'Save the Last Dance for Me'.

16> The Zombies - Released in 1964, 'She's Not There' was the Zombies' debut single.

17> Herman's Hermits - A cover, Herman's Hermits took the song to number one on the US Billboard Hot 100 in May of 1965.

18> The Dave Clark Five - Released in 1964, Glad All Over was the group's first big hit.19> The Yardbirds - Released in 1965, 'For Your Love' was Cream's highest charting single in the United States.

20> The Kinks - Released in 1964, Rolling Stone placed the song at number 82 on their

list of the 500 greatest songs of all time.
