- 1> T'Pring - The episode features Spock returning to his home world for a brutal Vulcan mating ritual.
- 2> Doctor Who - Twelve doctors have headlined in the series as the Doctor.
- 3> The Zanti Misfits - Often compared to The Twilight Zone, the Outer Limits aired from 1963 to 1965.
- 4> Buddy, the co-worker - The winner of 15 Emmy Awards, the show starred Dick Van Dyke, Rose Marie, Morey Amsterdam and Mary Tyler Moore.
- 5> Pandora Spocks - Bewitched broadcast for eight seasons from 1964 to 1972.
- 6> Puerto Rico - Starring Sally Field, the series focussed on the adventures of a community of nuns.
- 7> Hal - Hazel told the ongoing story of live-in maid Hazel Burke and her employers, the Baxters.
- 8> Alan Hale, Jr. - During the seventies, two made for TV movies where aired about the castaways - Rescue from Gilligan's Island and The Castaways on Gilligan's Island.
- 9> John Steed - Airing on the 7th of January 1961, the pilot episode was titled 'Hot Snow'.
- 10> The Green Hornet - The Green Hornet ran for one season in 1966–1967.
- 11> Butch Patrick - In May 2011, Patrick announced that he had been diagnosed with prostate cancer.
- 12> Toots Thielmans - Toots also whistled the melody in commercials for Old Spice cologne.
- 13> Della Street - The fictional defense attorney Perry Mason was created by Erle Stanley Gardner.
- 14> Gomer Pyle, U.S.M.C. - The first season of the show aired in black and white.
- 15> The Addams Family - The Addams Family ran from September 18, 1964 to October 30, 1977.
- 16> Fred - Running for six seasons, 'The Lucy Show' was Lucille Ball's follow-up to her previous show 'I Love Lucy'.
- 17> Rose Elly - Running for nine seasons, the Beverly Hillbillies starred Buddy Ebsen, Irene Ryan, Donna Douglas, and Max Baer, Jr.
- 18> Steve McQueen - Wanted Dead or Alive was a spin-off of a March 1958 episode of Trackdown.
