- 2> Jean Vander Pyl - She also did the voice of Wilma Flintstone.
- 3> Daisy Moses - The show's theme song was 'The Ballad of Jed Clampett'.
- 4> Lisa Loring - Lisa went on to play Cricket Montgomery on 'As The World Turns'.
- 5> Major - Howard Caine played the role of Major Wolfgang Hochstetter.
- 6> Long Branch - The series ran for 20 seasons from 1955 to 1975.
- 7> Betty Joe - Uncle Joe also ran the hotel for a few shows.
- 8> William Daniels - Captain Nice ran from January to May in 1967.
- 9> Cloyd and Gidney - The pilot for the show was called 'Rocky the Flying Squirrel'.
- 10> 1960 - Andy is a widowed sheriff of the fictional town of Mayberry, North Carolina.
- 11> Yvonne DeCarlo - De Carlo's final appearance before her death was as Aunt Rosa in the 1991 comedy Oscar.
- 12> Israel - The series was set in the 1770s.
- 13> Eb - Green Acres aired from September 15, 1965 to April 27, 1971.
- 14> Golden yellow - Kirk is played by William Shatner.
- 15> Ponderosa - Bonanza ranks as the second longest running western series behind Gunsmoke.
- 16> Get Smart - The series centers on the incompetent secret agent Maxwell Smart.
- 17> Lt. Carpenter - McHale's Navy ran for 138 episodes over four seasons.
- 18> Bewitched - Bewitched was ranked #50 on 'TV Guide's 50 Greatest TV Shows of All Time' in 2002.
- 19> The Man from U.N.C.L.E. - U.N.C.L.E. was an acronym for the United Network Command for Law and Enforcement.
- 20> Batman - 120 episodes of the show were produced for the 3 seasons that it ran.
