- 4> Rod Stewart - People said Stewart sold out to disco with this one, but in 1979 disco was king.
- 5> Bob Dylan - Released in 1975, it's filled with bittersweet love songs and angst-ridden confessionals.
- 6> Supertramp - Contained 'Give a Little Bit', which became Supertramp's first Top 20 hit in the U.S.
- 7> Bob Dylan - Released in 1975, it was subject to mixed reviews.
- 8> Queen - Contained the hits 'We Will Rock You' and 'We Are the Champions'.
- 9> Queen - 'A Day At The Races' and 'A Night At The Opera' are titled after The Marx Bro. films.
- 10> Derek and The Dominoes - Eric Clapton was a member of each of these bands.
