## Answers:

- 1> Crazy - Crazy Little Thing Called Love reached Billboard number one in February of 1980 where it stayed for 4 weeks.
- 2> (Just Like) Starting Over - (Just Like) Starting Over can be found on the Double Fantasy album released on November 17th, 1980.
- 3> REO Speedwagon - REO Speedwagon got its name from the REO Speed Wagon, a flatbed truck and fire engine.
- 4> Bette Davis - Bette Davis Eyes was number one on the Billboard charts for five weeks.
- 5> Paula Abdul - Paula was a cheerleader for the Los Angeles Lakers.
- 6> Thorn - Poison has sold over 30 million records worldwide.
- 7> Be Happy - Don't Worry Be Happy made it to number one on the Billboard chart in 1988.
- 8> Egyptian - The Bangles started their group as 'The Colours'.
- 9> U2 - U2 is from Dublin, Ireland.
- 10> Michael Jackson - Michael Jackson had 8 number one hits, 9 if you count Say Say Say with Paul McCartney.
- 11> Foreigner - 'I Want to Know What Love is' was number one on the Billboard chart for 3 consecutive weeks.
- 12> Bonnie Tyler - Bonnie Tyler was the first western artist to tour the Soviet Union.
- 13> The Final Countdown - 'The Final Countdown' was released on an album of the same name, which sold 3 million copies.
- 14> Tiffany - The song was originally recorded by Tommy James and the Shondells in 1967.
- 15> Soft Cell - Soft Cell have sold 10 million records worldwide.
- 16> Dancing in the Street - Dancing in the Street was number one on the charts for 4 consecutive weeks.
