- 1> Contact - Contact was based on a Carl Sagan novel of the same name.
- 2> Uma Thurman - Thurman won a Golden Globe Award for the miniseries Hysterical Blindness.
- 3> Forrest Gump - Forrest Gump won six Academy Awards including Best Picture, Best Director, Best Actor (for Tom Hanks) and Best Adapted Screenplay.
- 4> Al Pacino - The movie is based on a book by Andrew Neiderman.
- 5> Rocky Mountain Rescue - The film was nominated for three Academy Awards.
- 6> David Thewlis - Sean Connery was the voice of Draco, the last remaining dragon.
- 7> Gas - The movie failed to recoup its production costs.
- 8> Jason Alexander - One of the most financially successful romantic comedy movies, Pretty Woman made about \$464 million.
- 9> Species - The movie is about a group of scientists who try to trap a killer alien seductress before she successfully mates with a human male.
- 10> George Clooney and Chris O'Donnell - Batman and Robin received 11 nominations at the Razzie Awards, including one for Worst Picture.
- 11> Face/Off - The movie was released in 1997.
- 12> Joey Lauren Adams - Ben Affleck starred as Holden McNeil.
- 13> Robin Williams - Aladdin was the most successful film of 1992, earning over \$217 million.
- 14> Stomach and Head - Released in 1992, the film has become a cult hit.
- 15> Peter Jackson - The film features Melanie Lynskey and Kate Winslet in their screen debuts.
- 16> Minnesota - Receiving seven Academy Award nominations, Fargo won two for Best Original Screenplay and Best Actress in a Leading Role for McDormand.
