- 3> 1999 - Believe won the Grammy for Best Dance Recording.
- 4> Eagles - Hell Freezes Over went to number one on the US Billboard 200 chart where it stayed for two weeks.
- 5> Playground - 'This Used to be my Playground' was the theme for the film 'A League of Their Own'.
- 6> Norwood - Her complete name is Brandy Rayana Norwood.
- 7> Roxette - Roxette formed in 1986.
- 8> 2 - Hold On and Release Me both went to number one in 1990.
- 9> Prince - As of 2015, Prince has had thirty Top 40 singles during his career.
- 10> Aladdin - Aladdin was released in 1992.
- 11> Boyz II Men - Formed in 1988, Boyz II Men were originally known as Unique Attraction.
- 12> Swedish - Ace of Base is the third-most successful band from Sweden of all time, after the bands ABBA and Roxette.
- 13> Aqua - Aqua were originally called Joyspeed.
- 14> Drums - Torpey announced that he has Parkinson's Disease on July 25, 2014.
- 15> Vision of Love - As of 2015, Mariah has won five Grammy Awards.
- 16> Green Day - Green Day has won five Grammy Awards.
- 17> 1990 - Bolton has had two number one hits on the Billboard charts.
- 18> World - Clapton recorded the song for the soundtrack of the 1996 film, Phenomenon.
- 19> You - Falling into You is one of the best-selling albums of all time with over \$32 million sales.
