- 3> There Will Be Blood - Daniel Day-Lewis broke a rib during the filming.
- 4> Ian Holm - Martin Freeman portrays Young Bilbo in the newest film adaptation of "The Hobbit - There and Back Again".
- 5> Sandra Bullock - Sandra Bullock experienced a few crashes herself. Four years prior to 'Crash', she endured a jet crash, and in 2008, a drunken driver hit her car.
- 6> Eddie Vedder - 'Into The Wild' was the first Vedder solo album.
- 7> The Ladykillers - Bruce Campbell makes a cameo in the film. He is the Humane Society worker.
