- 5> Czechoslovakia - Became famous for his attempt to reform the Communist regime.
- 6> Mexico - Was president of Mexico from 1917 until his death in 1920.
- 7> Democratic Republic of the Congo - Patrice Lumumba was the first elected Prime Minister of the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
- 8> Egypt - Anwar Al Sadat was the third President of Egypt from October 15, 1970 until his assassination in 1981.
- 9> Pakistan - Leader of the All India Muslim League who founded Pakistan.
- 10> Swaziland - Mswati III is King of Swaziland and the head of the Swazi Royal Family.
- 11> Portugal - Prime Minister of Portugal from 1932 to 1968.
- 12> Yugoslavia - Leader of the Second Yugoslavia, which lasted from 1943 until 1991.
- 13> Singapore - Prime Minister of the Republic of Singapore from 1959 to 1990.
- 14> Dominican Republic - Rafael Trujillo ruled the Dominican Republic from 1930 until his assassination in 1961.
