- 5> Wings Winner of the first Academy Award for Best Picture in 1927, Wings is a silent full-length romantic action-war picture.
- 6> Daniel Day-Lewis Daniel has won three Best Actor Oscars during his career.
- 7> 2001 This movie starred Russell Crowe and Ed Harris.
- 8> American Beauty Kevin won numerous other film awards for his role in the film.
- 9> The Bridge on the River Kwai Released in 1957, The Bridge on the River Kwai was based on the 1952 novel Le Pont de la Riviere Kwai by Pierre Boulle.
- 10> Lisa She played the part of Lisa in the Oscar winning film, Girl Interrupted.
- 11> The Godfather The Lord of the Rings trilogy also received nominations for each movie.
- 12> Kathryn Bigelow Kathryn was the first woman to win the Academy Award for Best Director.
- 13> They Shoot Horses, Don't They? 'They Shoot Horses, Don't They' is based on the 1935 novel of the same name by Horace McCoy.
- 14> All the King's Men Robert Warren won the Pulitzer Prize for All the King's Men in 1947. Adapted for film in 1949 and 2006, the 1949 version won the Academy Award for Best Picture.
- 15> Chariots of Fire Released in 1981, Chariots of Fire was nominated for seven Academy Awards and won four, including Best Picture.
