- 1> Great Pyramid of Giza - The Great Pyramid of Giza is also called the Pyramid of Khufu.
- 2> The Temple of Artemis - The Temple of Artemis is also called the Temple of Diana.
- 3> The Hunt - Artemis is often depicted with a bow and arrows.
- 4> 250 BC - It was built by the Ptolemaic Kingdom.
- 5> The Hanging Gardens of Babylon - The legend says he created the garden for his Persian wife, Queen Amytis.
- 6> Iraq - All that remains of this once glorious city is a large mound.
- 7> Mausolus - This Mausoleum was built for Mausolus and his wife Artemisia II of Caria.
- 8> Mausoleum at Halicarnassus - The Mausoleum at Halicarnassus was built in about 350 BC.
- 9> Colossus of Rhodes - The Colossus of Rhodes was built in the city of Rhodes.
- 10> Statue of Zeus at Olympia - This giant statue of Zeus was said to be 43 feet tall.
- 11> Turkey - This wonder was constructed about 350 BC.
- 12> Great Pyramid of Giza - The Great Pyramid of Giza is believed to have been constructed as a tomb for Khufu.
- 13> The Lighthouse of Alexandria - The remnants were found at the bottom of the harbor.
- 14> The Temple of Artemis - His name is now used to describe a person who commits a crime in order to become famous.
- 15> The Lighthouse of Alexandria - The Citadel was a fortress, which was built upon the site where the Lighthouse once stood.
