- 1> Australia - The Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest.
- 2> Hippopotamus - Hippopotamuses are extremely aggressive animals and can attack without provocation.
- 3> Platypus - The platypus is a semiaquatic egg-laying mammal.
- 4> Five ants - An ant has six legs that are attached to its thorax - three on each side.
- 5> Eucalyptus - The koala is a marsupial that is native to Australia.
- 6> 14 - A Panda can eat up to 27 pounds of bamboo a day.
- 7> Water - Named the kangaroo rat because they can jump up to nine feet at once.
- 8> Swan - Geese and ducks are close relatives to the swan.
- 9> Willow - Medicines derived from willow trees date back to ancient Sumer.
- 10> Army - A group of cats is called a clowder.
- 11> Snow Leopard - The national bird of Afghanistan is the Golden Eagle.
- 12> Capybara - The capybara has a barrel-shaped body and short head.
- 13> Black - It is believed that the giraffe's tongue is black to protect it from sunburn.
- 14> Mauritius - The Mauritius Island is east of Madagascar in the Indian Ocean.
- 15> Strawberry - Strawberries are high in vitamin C.
- 16> Germany - The Doberman Pinscher was developed by Karl Friedrich Louis Dobermann sometime around 1890.
- 17> Parasitic Worm - Helminthiasis is the medical condition of being infected with parasitic worms.
- 18> Shark - There are over 500 species of sharks.
- 19> Lodge - Beavers are good swimmers and can stay under water for up to 15 minutes.

20> Amazon Rainforest - The Amazon Rainforest encompasses 7,000,000 square kilometers.
