8> Wolves - The Grey is based on the short story 'Ghost Walker' by Ian MacKenzie Jeffers.

9> 19 - The largest macaws are Buffon's Great Green and Green-Winged Macaws.

10> Water Buffalo - Most of the Mozzarella cheeses available today are made from cow's milk.

11> Bongo - The Bongo is one of the largest of the African forest antelope species.

12> Crocodile - Lacoste was founded in 1933.

13> Cuckoo - Some roadrunners have been clocked at 20 miles per hour.

14> Goliath - The Goliath Frog can grow up to 12.6 in in length and weigh up to 7.17 lbs.

- 15> Canaries - Well into the 20th century, coal miners brought canaries into coal mines for the purpose of detecting toxic gases.
- 16> Chick - Penguins live almost exclusively in the Southern Hemisphere.
- 17> Bivouac - When on the move, the army ants set up bivouacs at new sites each night.
- 18> Hummingbird - Hummingbirds are among the smallest of birds in the world.
- 19> Owl - Hedwig was given to Harry as a birthday present by Rubeus Hagrid.
- 20> Seal - The Japanese sea lion and the Caribbean monk seal have become extinct in the past century.
