1> Craig Stansberry - Craig only lived in Saudi for three months. His father was working there at the time of his birth. Craig went to school in the United States.

3> Fernando Tatis - Tatis accomplished this amazing feat on April 23rd, 1999. He was playing for St. Louis Cardinals.

4> Mark Bellhorn - Mark was able to accomplish this on August 29th 2002. Carlos did it on the 8th of April, 1993.

5> Barry bonds - Barry Bonds had this happen twice, once in May of 2004 and again in September.

6> South Vietnam - Danny is the only major league player in history to be born in this country. The Cleveland Indians drafted him in 1994.

7> Baltimore - Oriole Park has been home to the Baltimore Orioles since 1991. This stadium can hold more than 45, 000 fans.

8> Turner Field - Turner field is located in Atlanta, Georgia. This was the second time that this city hosted the game.

9> Oakland Athletics - The coliseum is home to both the Oakland Athletics and the Oakland Raiders.

10> Chicago Cubs - Thomas S. Ricketts bought the team, and became the CEO. His parents and siblings also own a portion of the team.

11> Mark Reynolds - Mark Reynolds struck out 223 times in 2009. He plays both third base and first base.

12> Jimmy Rollins - Jimmy set this record in 2007. He was playing for the Philadelphia Phillies when he set this record.

13> Alex Pompez - Alex served on the Hall of Fame special committee on Negro League Baseball in the 70s. Due to his involvement with organized crime in the 20s, he had to flee the country.

14> Ichiro Suzuki - Ichiro had 262 hits during the 2004 season. He was born in Japan.

15> Milwaukee Brewers - In 2010, Ned became the manager for the Kansas City Royals.
