9> Chris Beard - Chris Beard's first album 'Barwalkin' was released in 1997.

10> Jeff Healey - Jeff dies in 2008. He died of cancer.

12> Sean Costello - Sean was only 28 when he died. Sean suffered from a bipolar disorder.

13> John Mayer - John won the Grammy in 2003.

14> Colin James - James gave a command performance for Queen Elizabeth in Saskatchewan.

15> Thornetta Davis - Thornetta has also released her own solo albums. She released 'Shout Out to the Dusthuffer' in 1995.
