- 6> Munchkins - This game was originally a card game.
- 7> LIFE - LIFE is produced by Milton Bradley.
- 8> Five - The game was originally put out by Milton Bradley.
- 9> Battleship - Battleship is often played using just a pencil and a piece of paper.
- 10> Shadow Hunters - The game was created by Yasutaka Ikeda.
- 11> Risk - The game of Risk was originally released in 1957.
- 12> 16 - There are four different colors of circles.
- 13> Kill Doctor Lucky - In Clue, the object is to solve a murder, but in Kill Doctor Lucky, the object is to kill the doctor.
- 14> Razzia - The game was created by Reiner Knizia.
- 15> Balderdash - Balderdash was released in 1984.
