Answers:

1> Risk - There are many different versions of the game, such as Lord of the Rings edition, Star Wars edition and the Transformers edition.

2> Russia - There have been seven chess grandmasters from Russia, 3 from Ukraine, 3 from Azerbaijan and 2 from the US.

3> India - The ladders symbolise virtues, the snakes - vices and sins.

4> Go - Go was a mandatory game for the generals in ancient China.

5> H.P. Lovecraft - In the first version of the game, it was almost impossible to win.

6> Baratheon - Dragonstone is the capital city of Stannis Baratheon.

7> Life - According to Leo, the board game is better than real Life, because in the game he has kids.

8> Taxi - Scotland Yard won the Game of the Year award in 1983.

9> Scrabbles - The TV show proved to be a failure.

10> Quoridor - The game won the Mensa Mind Game Award in 1997.

11> Chinook - Chinook eventually "solved" checkers, meaning it has a complete database of all the possible moves in checkers.

12> Hyperbackgammon - The game is at least 5000 years old.

13> Taboo - Even if you don't like the game, you have to admit that the buzzer could prove quite useful.

14> Cyvasse - Although the exact rules are not stated in the book, it sounds much like a mix of chess, risk, stratego and Dungeons and Dragons.
