- 1> Rocky Balboa - Portrayed by Sylvester Stallone, Rocky Balboa, is the fictional character from the Rocky film series from 1975 to 2006.
- 2> Lennox Lewis - As an amateur, Lennox won gold while representing Canada at the 1988 Olympic Games.
- 3> Earnie Shavers - Earnie won his first fight with a first round knockout against Jim Daniels.
- 4> Joe Louis - Considered one of the greatest heavyweights of all time, Louis was the World Heavyweight Champion from 1937 to 1949.
- 5> Jake LaMotta - Jake also had the nickname 'The Bronx Bull'.
- 6> James Smith - James was the first ever heavyweight champion with a college degree.
- 7> George Foreman - In November 1994, at the age 45, George regained the Heavyweight Championship by knocking out Michael Moorer making him the oldest Heavy Weight Champion ever.
- 8> Ray Mancini - Ray held the lightweight championship from 1982 to 1984.
- 9> Jack Dempsey - Jack held the World Heavyweight Championship from 1919 to 1926.
- 10> Marvin Hagler - Hagler was the undisputed middleweight champion for over six years, the second longest of the last century.
- 11> Jack Johnson - Jack was the first African American world heavyweight boxing champion from 1908 to 1915.
- 12> Bernard Hopkins - Bernard defended his world middleweight title a record 20 times.
- 13> Rocky Marciano - Rocky died in a plane crash at the age of 46 in 1969.
- 14> Mohammed Ali - Ali won 56 of the 61 fights he fought.
- 15> Evander Holyfield - Holyfield won a bronze medal in the Light Heavyweight division at the 1984 Summer Olympics.
- 16> Apollo Creed - Apollo Creed is a fictional character from the Rocky films.
