- 1> Don't Let Me Be Misunderstood - Originally recorded by Nina Simone in 1964, the Animals released their version in 1965.
- 2> Season of the Witch - Considered one of the first psychedelic songs, Donovan released the song on his album Sunshine Superman in 1966.
- 3> Glad All Over - Glad All Over was a single released in 1963 by the Dave Clark Five.
- 4> All Day and All of the Night - All Day and All of the Night was released as a single by the Kinks in 1964.
- 5> Sympathy for the Devil - Released by The Rolling Stones on their album Beggar's Banquet in 1968.
- 6> She's Not There - Released in 1964 by The Zombies on their album Begin Here.
- 7> I'm Into Something Good - Released in 1964 by Herman's Hermits on their album Herman's Hermits.
- 8> Can't Buy Me Love - Primarily written by Paul McCartney, The Beatles released the song on their A Hard Day's Night album in 1964.
- 9> Carrie Anne - Released in 1967 as a single by The Hollies.
- 10> Behind Blue Eyes - From The Who's album Who's Next, the song was released in 1971.
- 11> I'll Be There - Originally recorded by Bobby Darin in 1960, a cover of the song was a hit for Gerry and the Pacemakers.
- 12> Itchycoo Park - Written by Steve Marriott and Ronnie Lane, The Small Faces released the song as a single in 1967.
- 13> Nights In White Satin - Featured on the album Days of Future Passed, Moody Blues released the song in 1967.
- 14> Devil Woman - Released by Cliff Richard on the album I'm Nearly Famous.
- 15> You'll Never Walk Alone - Released by Gerry and the Pacemakers in 1963.
