- 8> Aftermath Released April 1966, Aftermath is the Stones' fourth studio album and the first to consist entirely of Mick Jagger/Keith Richards compositions.
- 9> The Kinks Brothers Dave and Ray Davies formed the Kinks in North London in 1963.
- 10> The Animals The House of the Rising Sun was recorded in just one take on May 18th, 1964.
- 11> Dizzee Rascal Dylan is also known by the pseudonyms Captain Roscoe and Raskit.
- 12> 1982 American artist Gloria Jones recorded the original version of "Tainted Love" in 1965.
- 13> (What's the Story) Morning Glory Noel Gallagher has stated that the song is about an imaginary friend who's gonna come and save you from yourself.
- 14> Blur Blur formed in Colchester in 1988.
- 15> Spice Girls Viva Forever! received some of the worst reviews of 2012 and shut down after seven months.
