6> Father Ted - Father Ted starred Dermot Morgan as Father Ted Crilly.

7> The Vicar of Dibley - Running from November 1994 to March 2015, the Vicar of Dibley has received many British Comedy Awards.

8> Only Fools and Horses - Green Green Grass stars John Challis, Sue Holderness and Jack Doolan.

9> Liverpool - The Liver Birds aired from April 1969 to January 1979, and again for a short period in 1996.

10> Just Good Friends - Airing for 3 seasons, the series follows the uncertain relationship between two ex-lovers.

11> A Fine Romance - The series won two BAFTA British Academy Television Awards.

12> The Inbetweeners - The US version of The Inbetweeners aired on MTV for one season.

13> Steptoe and Son - Steptoe and Son was remade in the US as Sanford and Son.

14> Rising Damp - Rising Damp aired from 1974 until 1978.

15> Bless This House - Starring Sid James and Diana Coupland, Bless This House ran from February 1971 to April 1976.
