- 1> Himeji Castle - Dating back to 1333, the Himeji Castle is also known as the White Egret Castle.
- 2> Malbork Castle - Malbork castle was constructed by the Teutonic Knights. It is also the largest brick building in Europe.
- 3> Hungary - This amazing castle is in Budapest.
- 4> Spis Castle - Spis Castle is located in Slovakia.
- 5> Kylemore Abbey - The Duke and Duchess of Manchester once owned Kylemore Abbey.
- 6> Bailey - This area is also referred to as a ward.
- 7> Garderobe - The garderobe is the bathroom.
- 8> Casa Loma - Casa Loma was the home of Sir Henry Pellat.
- 9> Catherine Palace - Built in the Rococo style, this fabulous castle is located in Tsarskoye.
- 10> Boldt Castle - This stone castle is located on the American side of the St. Lawrence River.
- 11> Bodiam Castle - Bodiam Castle dates back to the 14th century.
- 12> Blair Castle - Blair Castle is located in the Scottish Highlands.
- 13> Matsumoto Castle - Matsumoto Castle is located in Japan. People often call it Crow Castle because of its black exterior.
- 14> Trakoscan Castle - Trakoscan Castle is located in Croatia. There are some who believe that this castle was named for an earlier castle that once stood on the same site.
- 15> Windsor Castle - Numerous castles across Europe have been renovated and converted into museums and hotels.
- 16> Stollmeyer's Castle - Stollmeyer's Castle was built to look like Balmoral Castle, which is in Scotland.
