- 3> Jakob and Wilhelm - The Walt Disney films 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs' and 'Sleeping Beauty' were adapted from stories originally published by the Brothers Grimm.
- 4> Three years - Robert currently tops the Forbes list of 'Hollywood's Highest-Paid Actors'.
- 5> Jerry Reed - A country music star, Jerry Reed also appeared in more than a dozen films.
- 6> Perry Como - Perry received the 'Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award' in 2002.
- 7> Los Angeles, California - Marilyn was ranked as the sixth-greatest female star of all time by the American Film Institute in 1999.
