- 4> Wham! - Wham! donated all of the 'Last Christmas' royalties to help combat Ethiopian famine.
- 5> 1891 - The tradition was started by Salvation Army officer Captain Joseph McFee in 1891.
- 6> Steve Martin - Adam Sandler plays the role of Louie Capshaw in the film.
- 7> Pacific - Christmas Ridge is located on the southwestern side of Tampa Bay.
- 8> Tinsel - Tinsel was invented in Nuremberg sometime around 1610.
- 9> Silver Bells - Silver Bells was first performed by Bob Hope and Marilyn Maxwell.
