3> Here Comes Santa Claus - Here Comes Santa Claus was originally written and performed by Gene Autry in 1947.

4> White Christmas - Recorded by many artists, the public debut of the song was done by Bing Crosby on Christmas Day, 1941.

5> Andy Williams - Williams released the song on his first Christmas album on October 14, 1963.

6> Platinum Mine - 'Santa cutie, there's one thing I really do need, the deed to a platinum mine.'

- 7> Rudolph - Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer was created by Robert Lewis May.
- 8> I Pray on Christmas - From the album 'When My Heart Finds Christmas'.
- 9> Do You Hear What I Hear? - Written in October 1962 by Noel Regney and Gloria Shayne Baker.
- 10> Johnny Mathis - The lyrics were written by Fred Jay.
- 11> Santa Claus Is Coming to Town - Santa Claus Is Coming to Town has been covered by over 200 artists.
- 12> Winter Wonderland - Winter Wonderland was written by Felix Bernard and Richard B. Smith in 1934.
- 13> Peace on Earth/Little Drummer Boy - The single continues to chart during the Christmas season.
- 14> Frightful - 'Oh the weather outside is frightful, but the fire is so delightful!'
- 15> Jingle Bells - Jingle Bells was published under the title of "One Horse Open Sleigh" in 1857.
