- 10> Led Zeppelin One of the best-known classic rock bands of all time, Led Zeppelin was active from 1968 to 1980.
- 11> Journey Featured in 2005, a USA Today reader poll named Journey the fifth best American rock band in history.
- 12> The Who Unfortunately, Moon's drumming career was cut short when he died of a clomethiazole pill overdose at the age of 32.
- 13> Scotland Simple Minds formed in Glasgow, Scotland in 1977.
- 14> Bon Jovi Keep the Faith is Bon Jovi's fifth studio album release.
- 15> Lenny Stevie was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame on December 16, 2014.
