- 10> The Joshua Tree The Joshua Tree was the band's fifth studio album.
- 11> Boston In January of 2009, Boston re-released a remastered disc of their Greatest Hits.
- 12> Derek and the Dominos The album was entitled 'Layla and Other Assorted Love Songs', which was released in 1970.
- 13> The Who The song was written by Pete Townshend.
- 14> The Kinks Disbanded in 1996, The Kinks have had five top 10 singles on the US Billboard chart.
- 15> The Doobie Brothers The songs 'Long Train Runnin' and 'China Grove' are among their hits released in the seventies.
