4> Moscow - The majority of Russians live in the area between St. Petersburg and Moscow.

6> Switzerland - Lenin returned from Switzerland, thanks to the intervention of the Germans on 4/16/1917

7> Socialist - In theory, USSR was a democracy, but with only 1 party, in effect it was a dictatorship.

8> Viet Nam - 58,168 US soldiers died. The number has increased due to found remains.

9> Ho Chi Minh - He led the Vietnamese Communist Party.

10> London - While his philosophy had such a profound effect upon Russia, he never went there.

11> Joseph McCarthy - An attempt to root out communism with his own little version of the Spanish Inquisition.

12> The Hollywood Ten - They refused to give names and were jailed by the government, as well as, blacklisted by Hollywood.
