- 1> Catholic Europe - Catholic Europe was attempting to control and convert various other religious people in the Middle East.

- 4> Jerusalem - The city was captured in July 1099.
- 5> Destriers - Palfreys and hackneys were riding horses.
- 6> Byzantines - The term Byzantine refers to the citizens of the Byzantine Empire.
- 7> Pope Eugene III - This was the first crusade to be lead by European Kings.
- 8> Louis VII - The German King at the time was Conrad III.
- 9> Richard I - Richard I is better known as Richard the Lionhearted.
- 10> Leopold V, Duke of Austria - The British king was held at Durstein Castle.
- 11> 1189 - The crusade lasted until 1192.
- 12> 1169 - Saladin was a general in the Seljuk army.
- 13> Egypt - The crusade was planned but never executed due to in-fighting.
- 14> Jerusalem - The crusaders captured Jaffa in 1192.
- 15> Fell off his horse - On the 10th of June 1190, Frederick's horse slipped while crossing the river.
