5> A Bug's Life - A Bug's Life was inspired by Aesop's fable The Ant and the Grasshopper.

6> Her Voice - The Little Mermaid is based on a Hans Christian Andersen fairy tale of the same name.

7> Parrot - Aladdin is based on the folktale Aladdin and the Magic Lamp from One Thousand and One Nights.

8> Hans Zimmer - The Lion King won two Academy Awards for its musical score.

9> Pinocchio - Pinocchio is based on the children's novel The Adventures of Pinocchio by Carlo Collodi.

- 10> Peter Pan - Based on the play Peter Pan, or The Boy Who Wouldn't Grow Up by J. M. Barrie.
- 11> Timothy - Disney's fourth Disney animated feature film, Dumbo is based on a children's story written by Helen Aberson.
- 12> Belle - Beauty and the Beast became Disney's first animated film to be adapted into a Broadway musical in 1994.
- 13> Owl - The Fox and the Hound is loosely based on a novel by Daniel P. Mannix.
- 14> Aladdin - Another Aladdin direct-to-video sequel was released in 1996 titled Aladdin and the King of Thieves.
- 15> The Little Mermaid - Under the Sea was written by Samuel E. Wright.
