1> Golgotha - Golgotha is outside the walls of Jerusalem.

2> Vinegar - After tasting the mixture, Jesus refuses to drink the rest.

3> Simon - The Bible states that Simon was a man from Cyrene.

4> Two - There was one on either side of him.

5> Theft - The name of these men is not given.

6> Joseph of Arimathea - Joseph went to Pilate and asked for the body.

7> Pontius Pilot - According to the Gospel of John, after writing the words Pilate said, 'What I have written, I have written'.

8> Legs - They were going to break the legs of Jesus, but found that he was dead.

9> Seven - According to the gospel of Mark, Jesus first appears to Mary of Magdalene.

10> The first day of the week - This wording appears in the Gospels of Mark, John, Matthew and Luke.

11> Passover - Passover recognizes the emancipation of the Israelites.

12> 12 - Including Jesus, there were thirteen people at the meal. This is one of the theories as to why thirteen is an unlucky number.

13> His ear was cut off - According to Luke, Jesus healed the injury.

14> Peter - Jesus foretells the event. After the first denial, Peter cries bitterly. This incident is often referred to as the Repentance of Peter.

15> Barabbas - Pilate permits the crowd to choose who will be released, and they select Barabbas.

16> He kisses Jesus - Judas Iscariot was given money to betray Jesus.
