- 1> London - As of 2001, London had a population of over eight million people.
- 2> Wales - The border with Wales is 160 miles long.
- 3> Marshall Meadows, Northumberland - Lizard Point, Cornwall is the southernmost point.
- 4> Scafell Pike - It is located in Lake District National Park, in Cumbria.
- 5> Isle of Wight - Isle of Wight has a land area of approximately 147 square miles.
- 6> River Thames - River Thames is the second longest river in the United Kingdom.
- 7> Windermere - Lake Windermere can be found entirely within the Lake District National Park.
- 8> 8 Percent - Urban development accounts for 21 percent.
- 9> Canary Island - Canary Islands are owned by Spain.
- 10> Canonteign Falls - Canonteign Falls can be found within Dartmoor National Park.
- 11> 326 - Districts are used for the purposes of local government.
- 12> Devon - Dartmoor covers 368 square miles.
- 13> Edinburgh - Edinburgh can be found in Scotland.
- 14> France - The English Channel joins the North Sea to the Atlantic Ocean.
- 15> 2 Percent - Water privatisation in England was undertaken in 1989.
