- 7> Mont Blanc - This mountain is 4,810m high.
- 8> Switzerland - The Statlhorn is 4,109 m high.
- 9> Aiguille Verte - All the other mountains are in Switzerland.
- 10> The Volga - The Volga drains into the Caspian Sea.
