- 1> Cranberry - The very first Thanksgiving was celebrated by the Pilgrims in 1621.
- 2> Chop Suey - Chop suey was most likely invented in America by Chinese Americans.
- 3> Squid - Calamari is traditionally found in Mediterranean and Asian cuisines.
- 4> Raspberry - Raspberries are part of the rose family.
- 5> China - Peking Duck has been prepared in China since the imperial era.
- 6> Snails - May 24th is 'National Escargot Day' in the United States.
- 7> Ascorbic Acid - Since Vitamin C is a water-soluble vitamin, your body doesn't store it.
- 8> Greece - Feta is made with sheep's milk, or sometimes from a mixture of sheep and goat's milk.
- 9> Bark - Cinnamon was highly prized among ancient nations.
- 10> Gin - Created in 1919, the White Lady originally featured creme de menthe in place of gin.
- 11> Sturgeon - Considered a delicacy, Caviar is eaten as a garnish or a spread.
- 12> Turnip - Turnip is a root vegetable.
- 13> Greece - Moussaka consists of eggplant and/or potatoes with minced meat.
- 14> Green tea - Matcha is made from shade-grown tea leaves.
- 15> Banana - Plantains are unsuitable raw.
- 16> Cabbage - Sauerkraut is cabbage that has been fermented by lactic acid bacteria.

- 17> Rear Back - In the United Kingdom, the word sirloin refers to cuts of meat from the upper middle of the cow.
- 18> Cucumber - Solyanka is prepared by cooking cucumbers with brine and then adding other ingredients.
- 19> Orange - Triple Sec is flavored with dried peels of bitter and sweet oranges.
- 20> Comal - Comals are generally made from heavy cast iron.
