- 1> Tom Collins - The drink is typically served in a tall glass over ice.
- 2> Bean - A flageolet is a small, light green, kidney-shaped bean.
- 3> Switzerland - Raclette is most commonly used for melting.
- 4> C - Vitamin C's chemical formula is C₆H₈O₆.
- 5> Sweden - Artsoppa is a pea or split pea soup.
- 6> Ciabatta - Ciabatta is a white bread made with olive oil.
- 7> Greece - Souvlaki is often served with pita bread, potatoes and dips.
- 8> Bread - Roti is made from stoneground wholemeal flour and water.
- 9> Lamb - Greek dishes made with beef are uncommon.
- 10> Singapore Sling - The drink was originally called a gin sling.
- 11> Avocado - Avocados were originally called alligator pears.
- 12> China - Rare, the dish is highly prized in China for its high nutritional value and exquisite flavor.
- 13> Orange - Kumquats are the only citrus fruit that can be eaten 'skin and all'.
- 14> Egg - Advocaat is made from eggs, sugar and brandy.
- 15> Hungary - The main ingredients found in Goulash are meat, noodles, potatoes and other vegetables, paprika and spices.
