2> Sugar - Caramelized custard is baked in a caramel-lined mold and served chilled with the caramel side up.

3> The flesh is poisonous - The restaurant preparation of fugu is rigorously controlled by law in Japan.

4> Tea - Other than water, tea is the most commonly consumed drink in the world.

5> Tannic acid - Tea also contains catechins, a type of antioxidant.

6> Cuba - Black bean soup is another frequently prepared Cuban favorite.

7> Brown sugar - Brown sugar contains from 3.5 percent molasses (light variety) to 6.5 percent molasses (dark variety).

8> Belgian waffle - The waffles were served with whipped cream and strawberries, and sold for a dollar.

9> Octopus - There are around 300 different species of octopus.

10> Saccharin - Saccharin was first fashioned in 1878 by Constantin Fahlberg, a chemist working on coal tar derivatives.

11> Tahini - Tahini is made from sesame seeds that are saturated in water and then crushed to detach the bran from the kernels.

12> Vodka - Although the drink is not Russian in origin, it is so named due to vodka being the primary ingredient.
